**Gabrielle I. Noyes**

For those who have graduated from CCC since 1987, and there are more than 4,200 of them, Gabrielle is Miss Noyes, a gifted and inspirational math teacher who can ignite a passion for mathematics and for learning in students who didn't even know it was there to ignite.

Gabrielle earned a B.S. in education and a M.Ed. in Curriculum and Instruction in Mathematics Education from the University of South Florida. She began her career as a math teacher at CCC in 1987 and has taught everything from freshman algebra to advanced calculus. In 2010 Gabrielle became an adjunct professor in mathematics at St. Petersburg College (SPC). Beyond the classroom, Gabrielle has held various additional positions at CCC including School Administration Team member, Student Activities director, Mathematics department chair and advisor to the Mu Alpha Theta Math Honor Society (MHS). As advisor for MHS, she encouraged members to participate in service to the CCC community through a peer-to-peer tutoring program, and service within the larger community through work with Habitat for Humanity and beach clean-ups. She also developed the MHS Math Day which brings fourth grade students from our partner schools to CCC for a day of math games, challenges and fun with current CCC MHS students.

Over the years as a teacher at CCC, Gabrielle has volunteered innumerable hours as a tutor to not only her students but to alumni as well. She also volunteers her time on the CCC Alumni Athletic Hall of Fame committee and as an ambassador of the school providing tours during annual reunion events. Gabrielle has also been generous in her charitable giving to CCC and since 2000 has been an annual donor to the Central Catholic Fund – no other alumnus has given more consistently for a longer period of time.

A long-time parishioner at St. Catherine of Siena Catholic Church, Gabrielle serves and helps organize Eucharistic Ministers for the 9:00 a.m. Family Mass, and as an ever-present force within the parish, Gabrielle has coordinated parish work days and convent clean-ups involving her students and family members. She also assists with food bank services benefiting migrant families and, until recently, served on the church's advisory board. With her family, Gabrielle helps provide Thanksgiving meals to those in need through Operation Stone Soup, a Noyes family program begun in memory of their late mother, Mary Noyes.

In her online bio for SPC, Gabriella writes, "...you can be assured that I will be there to help you reach success..." Over the last 29 years, Gabrielle has indeed done just that at CCC and in the community.
