



COVID 19 Decision Tree - STUDENTS

YES SYMPTOMS

NO SYMPTOMS

- SYMPTOMS**
- Fever (>100.4F)
 - Sore Throat
 - New loss of smell or taste
 - Chills
 - New/Worsening Cough
 - New/Unusual Headaches
 - Unexplained Muscle Aches
 - Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea
- *Considerations will be made based on known pre-existing conditions

STUDENTS/PARENTS WILL

1. Notify administrator and stay home or if at school, student will be isolated and need to be picked up within 60 minutes.
 - a. Student having 2 or more symptoms AND/OR fever (>100.4F for >24hours) must be evaluated by physician and provide subsequent documentation to the school.
 - b. Student having unexplainable symptoms (i.e. headache, cough, vomiting) should be symptom free for 48 hours prior to returning to in-person learning.
 - c. Complete DOSP Contact Tracing Form

ADMINISTRATOR WILL

2. Contact Pastor (if applicable) & OCSC
3. Work with student/ family to complete DOSP Contact Tracing Form

Is Student aware of contact with someone who has been diagnosed with or tested positive for Covid-19?

If Covid-19 Testing is Prescribed/Mandated

If Student Tests Positive

If Student Tests Negative

STUDENTS/PARENTS WILL

1. Provide written documentation of results to administrator
2. Continue medical care as instructed
3. Return to school only after 10 days have passed since **test date of COVID-19 AND 24 hours have passed since fever / respiratory symptoms ended**

ADMINISTRATOR WILL

1. Notify Pastor (if applicable) & OCSC
2. Notify teachers and students listed on the Contact Tracing Form.
3. Implement school contingency plan if necessary, after consultation with local health department, Pastor, and OCSC
4. Send general communication to staff and parent community

STUDENTS/PARENTS WILL

1. Provide written documentation of results to administrator
2. Continue medical care as instructed
3. Return to school after 24 hours have passed from end of fever and general improvement of symptoms

ADMINISTRATOR WILL

1. Notify Pastor (if applicable) & OCSC

Yes, there was direct physical or close contact (less than 6 feet) for 15 minutes or more where neither party were using face masks or coverings.

****Immediate family members of a student (live in the same household) testing positive will result in a 14 day quarantine for student****

STUDENTS/PARENTS WILL

1. Notify administrator
2. Keep child at home and follow local school distance learning plan
3. Contact child's physician
4. Monitor by checking for fever and symptoms.
5. Follow CDC guidelines and **return to school only after 14 days have passed since last contact with Covid-19 positive person.**

ADMINISTRATOR WILL

1. Notify Pastor (if applicable) & OCSC
2. Work with Parents/Student to complete DOSP Contact Tracing Form

Yes, there was non-close contact (greater than 6 feet) and/or the contact lasted less than 15 minutes and/or face masks or coverings were used by one or both parties.

STUDENTS/PARENTS WILL

1. Parents-monitor by checking for fever and symptoms.
2. Continue practicing social distancing and good hygiene.
3. Follow directives for "YES SYMPTOMS" if symptoms appear.

ADMINISTRATOR WILL

1. No specific action is needed

No, the student is unaware of any contact with someone who is infected or diagnosed with Covid-19

STUDENTS/PARENTS WILL

1. Continue practicing social distancing and good hygiene

ADMINISTRATOR WILL

1. No specific action is needed
